



Israel is **Digitizing Arrival** for the benefit of all travelers.

Over the past few years, many countries have introduced the ETA protocol into their foreign national arrival procedures. It is in essence a type of pre-arrival registration, which helps expedite international arrival.

Israel will be joining this protocol on **August 1, 2024**. Citizens of all countries exempt from pre-arrival visas are eligible for this process. The intention is to streamline arrival procedures and to make the arrival experience at Ben Gurion Airport faster and more pleasant.

A few points:

- The protocol is in line with procedures used in the United States, Canada, the European Union and Australia
- The system will be up and running from June 1, 2024 for a **Pilot Period** of two months. The Pilot Period is applicable to citizens of the United States and Germany and is not obligatory.
- From August 1, 2024, all passengers entering Israel from countries that are exempt from pre-arrival visas, will be obligated to use the ETA protocol. The United States, Canada and most Western European countries, fall into this category.
- The registration process is quick and can be implemented online. The cost is 25 NIS, which is equivalent to approximately \$7 USD.
- Once you register, the registration is good for two years and each visit to Israel can be up to 90 days.
